Sun Awareness week 6-10 May

In anticipation of good weather in the weeks leading up to the end of term we have put our Care in the Sun policy on our website. We would ask parents to apply sun lotion if necessary before coming to school. Please note children should be able to apply any top up application necessary and children CAN NOT share lotions for health & safety reasons. Girls may wear their red checked summer dresses – boys may wear short trousers or in very hot weather they may come in their PE shorts and t shirts (fingers crossed). We will be participating in the Wrap, Slap and Hat Programme raising awareness of the dangers of the sun in school and a letter about this will be going home with your child so you can reinforce the importance of safety in the sun.
